Dear Mr. Robertson,

According to the Georgian legislation the conditions for the warehouse of the medication is regulated by the Law of Georgia on the Medicines and Pharmaceutical Activities and relevant legislative acts, and are as follows:


1. Space of the warehouse, planning and technical equipment in accordance with international and national regulations.
2. The warehouse ensures safety of the medications from the external harmful damages: light, humidity, evaporation, high/low temperature and natural gases.
3. In the warehouse is ensured management of remnants of the pharmaceutical products according to the legislation: accounting, safe segregation, collection, storage and utilization.
4. Warehouse has technical equipment for storage, shelving and distribution of pharmaceutical products.

In addition to the abovementioned requirements, because of the high market value of medicines, we deem necessary that the warehouse should be ensured with 24/7 armed security and surveillance. Such requirements are met by some of the warehouses, but as currently through Central Warehouse of Ministry of Internal Affairs of Georgia the storage and distribution of narcotics – morphine is undertaken, the warehouse of LEPL “Center for Mental Health and Prevention of Addiction” ensures storage of methadone supply, and through warehouse of “Medpharma Plus” the storage and distribution of Insulin and other medications, purchased in accordance to the State Programs are ensured, the safety of these Warehouses are ensured by armed security units and are equipped with alarms, security signalization of perimeter, video surveillance, vibration and smoke detectors, and therefore, we can recommend these 3:

1. Central Warehouse of Ministry of Internal Affairs of Georgia (#5 Kisikhi st., Tbilisi Georgia);
2. Warehouse of LEPL “Center for Mental Health and Prevention of Addiction” (#21a Kavtaradze st., Tbilisi, Georgia);
3. Warehouse of “Medpharma Plus”, LLC (#76/1 Uznadze st., Tbilisi, Georgia).
